















		Definition
	Getting started	The catalytic event that started things moving. This could be the convergence of ongoing activities around the Protective Factors framework, a first meeting of a leadership team, etc. There can be multiple instances of work "getting started"
	Champion	Someone who took on the Strengthening Families work and tirelessly moved it forward
	Crisis	An unexpected event that changed the circumstances of the work or the environment surrounding it
	Accomplishment, Achievement, Successes	An achievement, accomplishment, or success; something that is the result of Strengthening Families efforts to that point. For example, getting an unexpected partner to join the leadership team is an achievement.
	Product, Policy	Creation of a tangible product, such as a training curriculum or public education materials; this can also be used to describe when Strengthening Families concepts are embedded in policies or infrastructure
	Disseminating information	Efforts to broadcast the Strengthening Families approach and Protective Factors framework (or materials that incorporate them) to a broader audience, such as presenting at a conference or launching a public awareness campaign
	Getting critical (catalytic) information	Acquiring – intentionally or unintentionally – information that helps drive the work forward. This might be the collection of data that drives the Strengthening Families work or an introduction to a new and useful tool
	Lucky break	A serendipitous, unexpected event that benefits the state's initiative
	Looking to the Future	Anticipating ways to grow and deepen the initiative into the future. This can describe prospective results of ongoing work, or an instance of particular foresight or vision.
	Going out on a limb	Taking a risk to advance the work
	Money	Ways in which the presence or absence of money affects the development of the initiative
	Roadblocks and barriers	Factors that impede the development of the Strengthening Families work; these can be anticipated or unexpected
	Key connections and relationships	Connections are made and relationships are built; these affect the development of the work as different people bring their own knowledge and networks to Strengthening Families
	Overcoming obstacles	Challenges are met, problems are solved
